Dress Code Policy

Please observe the following dress code while on property:

The upper level- 1912 Grille, 1912 Lounge and Fireside Porch, Georgia Room, and Ballrooms:

The dress code for the upper level is business casual. Dress shoes and collared shirts are required for men. Dress denim is considered acceptable for both men and women. Tennis/Sport attire, tennis shoes, collarless shirts, and athletic or cargo shorts are not permitted. Men will not be permitted to wear caps, hats, golf shoes, or flip flops on the third floor. Hats and visors are permitted on the Fireside Porch.

All other areas:

Casual attire, including shorts and tennis shoes may be worn in all other areas of the Ansley Clubhouse, pool or fitness areas. Fitness attire is not permitted in the clubhouse, except in the locker rooms. Hats are not permitted in the general dining areas of the clubhouse, unless the social activity is formal such that hats are appropriate for women. Men shall not wear hats, other than in the Men's Locker and Grill Rooms.

Golf Course:

All golfers shall wear appropriate golf attire. Blue denim jeans, denim shorts, denim shirts, tennis shorts, cut-offs, frayed shorts, "short shorts," sweat pants, cargo shorts, athletic shorts, tank tops and halter tops are not permitted. Males are required to wear shirts with collars or crewneck golf shirts with a collar of no less than 1 1/4" in width. Hats shall be worn front bill and shirts shall be tucked in.

Mobile Devices Policy

The use of such devices is not permitted in either Clubhouse. Cell phones must be set on the silent mode while on Club premises but can be used for text messaging. Hand-held and touch-screen devices can be used for non-verbal communication. Hand-held devices can be used by children if the devices are muted.
